

Membership Dues Pledge Form 2017/2018 Fiscal Year

It is our belief that our annual membership pledges reflect our shared commitment to maintaining our Jewish community regardless of our own religious practice. Whether you are here once a year or weekly, Temple Shalom is here for you, and our community needs your support in return.

Last year, we transitioned to a voluntary dues model, rather than using a fixed dues schedule. All members are expected to submit a pledge amount. This allows us to forecast our income and plan for expenses. In addition, our software requires a pledge amount to operate correctly. Your family's support should be based on an accurate self-assessment of your ability to contribute, rather than a fixed dues schedule. It cost about \$1350 per family this past fiscal year to maintain our facility, offer Shabbat services, and various programming. As we know, since not every family is able to pay this amount, we ask that if possible every family that can, pledges 3% of their annual Gross Household Income as their share of the communal responsibility to preserve our synagogue. If you have it within your resources to be even more generous, we ask that you pledge as much as possible to help keep membership available to all.
